



The list below provides examples of event activities not permitted on public land:

- Reputation Risk - Where the Mayor and CEO are of the opinion that the activity will substantially damage the reputation of the council by associating the council with the activity.
- Events considered likely to incite violence, vilification or anti-social behaviour.
- Events involving any illegal or undesirable activity.
- Events that involve the use or promotion of illegal substances.
- Events considered inappropriate from the perspective of the NSW Police Force.
- Events that are perceived by the wider community as being disorderly, offensive or contrary to community taste or decency.
- Events that may be perceived as racist or coercive by the wider community.
