



The list below provides examples of filming/photography activities not permitted on public land:

- Reputation Risk - Where the Mayor and CEO are of the opinion that the filming activity will substantially damage the reputation of the council by associating the council with the activity.
- Filming or photography considered likely to incite violence, vilification or anti-social behaviour.
- Filming or photography of any illegal or undesirable activity.
- Filming or photography that involves use or promotion of illegal substances.
- Filming or photography Activities considered inappropriate from the perspective of the NSW Police Force.
- Filming or photography activities that are perceived by the wider community as being disorderly, offensive or contrary to community taste or decency.
- Filming or photography of activity perceived as racist or coercive by the wider community.
